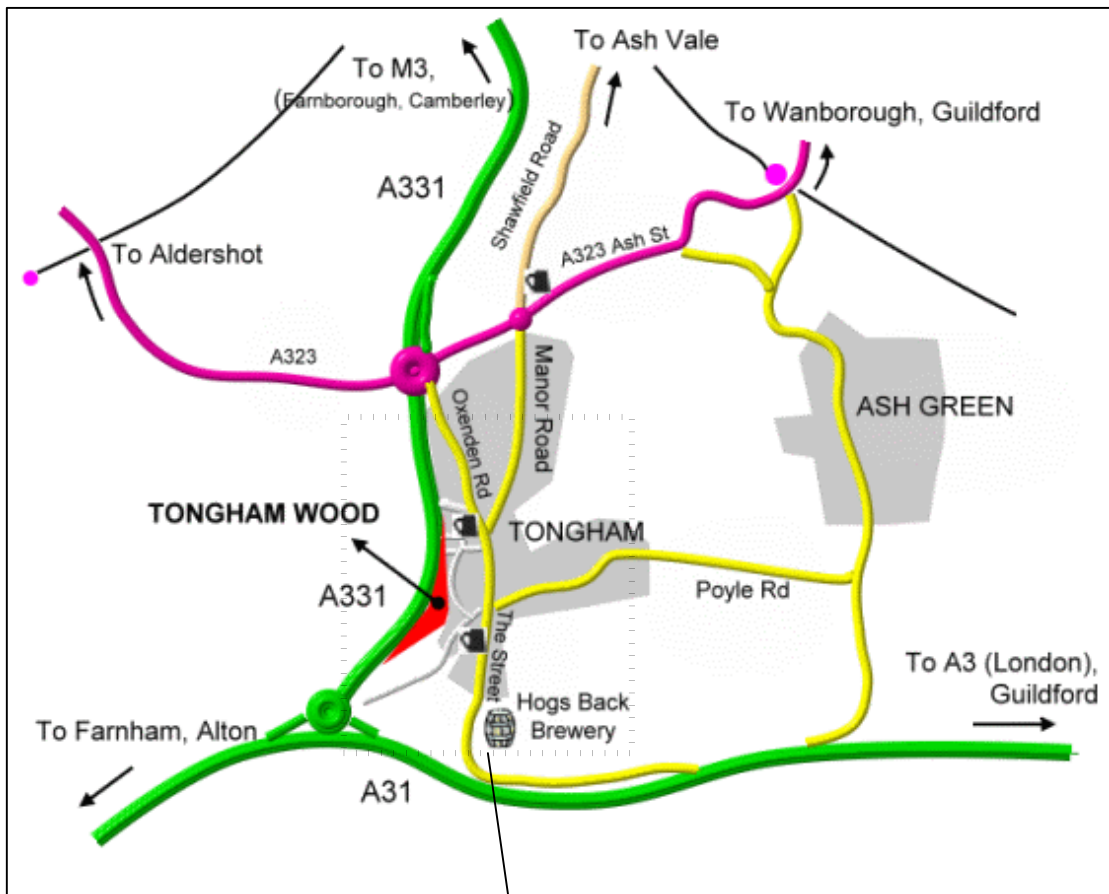





HOW TO GET TO TONGHAM COMMUNITY WOOD






Legend

ENTRANCES:

1) Main – off Garbetts Way (end of garages diagonally opposite Chester Way):

Wheelchair, bicycle, pushchair friendly. Parking.  

 **TIP:** look out for Garbetts Way road sign attached to wall at start of garages.

2) **End of The Moors:** Wheelchair, bicycle, pushchair friendly 

3) **End of Grieve Close:** Pedestrian only kissing gate. Parking. 

BY CAR:

Follow the map above.



TIP: Follow signs to the Hogs Back Brewery from the A31.



TIP: Take the 'Aldershot' exit off the A331.

BY BICYCLE / FOOT:

Additional routes available (see blue dotted line in map insert).

- 1) Via old railway line between Ash Green and Tongham, then by road to Garbetts Way entrance, through wood to The Moors exit, under subway (can detour via Tongham Pool on left), then follow Blackwater Valley Path.
- 2) Blackwater Valley Path (Heron Wood), under subway to The Moors entrance, exit at Garbetts Way, onto Grange Road towards Runfold (via Packham Antiques Warehouse).

BY TRAIN / BUS:

Nearest train stations: Ash Station, 25-30 mins walk or get bus from opposite side of the road. No. 20 bus (Guildford - Aldershot) to The Cricketers, Tongham stop.

Aldershot station, 30 mins walk or get bus from adjacent bus station. No.3 (Aldershot-Yateley) or No. 20 bus to Manor Road stop (press bell when The Cricketers is in view).

NEAREST REFRESHMENTS: The Cricketers Pub (The Moors), The White Hart Pub (Grange Road/The Street), The Bakery or Londis (The Street).
